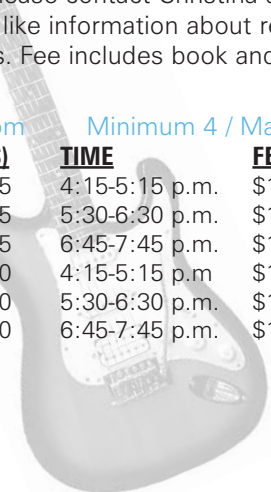
Guitar Lessons
