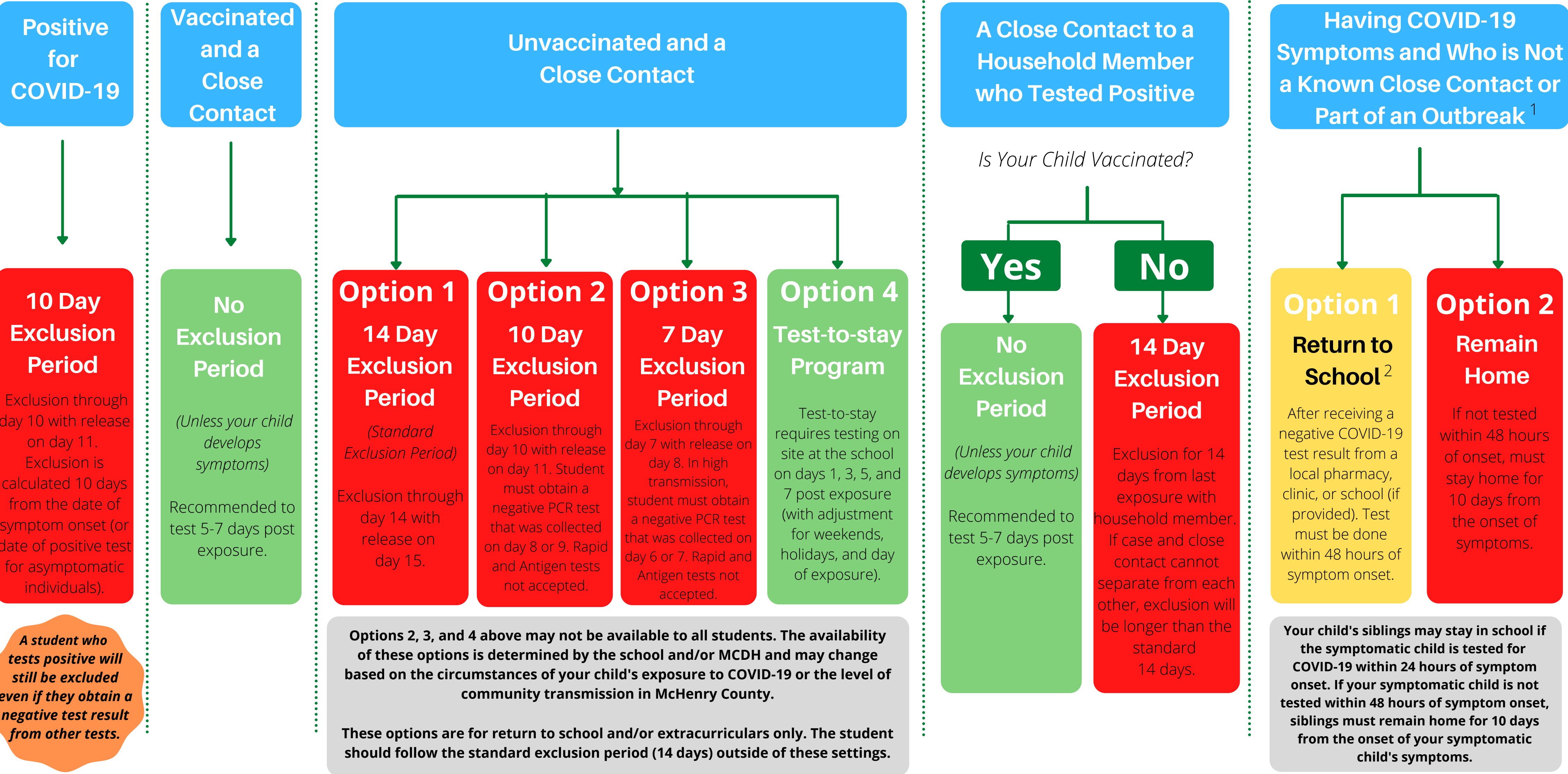


My Child is Impacted by COVID-19. What Do I Do Now?



My Child is...



This document provides a summary of how a COVID-19 positive, close contact, or symptomatic student may be impacted. Please note, each individual case will be evaluated on its own merits and MCDH has final say on all cases. Please reference the [McHenry County P-12 Interim School Guidance](#) for more information and updates due to increased transmission level of COVID-19.

1. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever (100.4°F or higher), new onset of moderate to severe headache, shortness of breath, new cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, new loss of sense of taste or smell, fatigue from unknown cause, muscle or body aches from unknown cause.
2. Even if your child tests negative for COVID-19, they should not return to school while experiencing certain symptoms (such as fever, vomiting, or diarrhea). Please follow your school's guidelines with regards to when a student can return to school for illnesses other than COVID-19.
