Jr. Red Raider Basketball Boys Team Roster Invitation Acceptance Form

Congratulations on being invited to play on a Jr. Red Raiders Basketball team at your grade level. The Jr. Red Raiders are a competitive basketball team with the goal of preparing the best 5th-8th grade players within District 158 boundaries for high school competition through participation in a league season against other community's high school feeder teams.

This signed acceptance form and the registration fee (\$250) are due by Friday Dec 1st. Players will not be able to participate in practice after that date until this has been completed. Any player who does not have this completed December 8th, will automatically be removed from the team roster and replaced by another player.

If you choose to accept this invitation, you must understand and agree to the items listed below and have the form signed and dated by both you and your parent/guardian.

- 1. All Jr. Red Raider players must reside within the boundaries of Huntley School District 158.
- 2. Players are expected to attend all team practices and games. Typically, practices will be two nights a week for 90 minutes each. Team will play a league schedule of up to 20 games. All teams will also play in a minimum of 3 tournaments, including our own Hoop Fest, February 24th and 25th 2018. Additional tournaments may be scheduled at the discretion of the individual teams at an additional per player cost.
- 3. Each team will have a team web site hosted by Team Snap. Players who participated on a Jr. Red Raiders team already have active accounts for this year's team and can log in starting on Monday 10/30 using their email address and password from last season. Prior to October 30th Team Snap may not have information posted for the upcoming season. New players will be sent an invitation to join Team Snap by October 30th. All practice, game, and tournament scheduling will be kept on this Team Snap site and players and parents are responsible for monitoring Team Snap regularly for schedule information
- 4. Players and spectators at all Jr. Red Raider games are expected to represent themselves and their community proudly. All teammates, coaches, opponents, referees, other spectators, and host facilities & staff should be treated with courtesy and respect.
- 5. **Playing time**: Game playing time will be at the sole discretion of the coaching staff based primarily on practice performance and player attitude. Each player will have the opportunity to earn game playing time and improve their skills through equal participation at practices. **There is no guaranteed or minimum required amount of game playing time for this program.**
- 6. If a player or parent has an issue they would like to address with the coaching staff, it should be done before or after practice, or at some other time away from the court. The time during practice, and before/during/after games should be reserved for the coaching staff to provide their full focus on the team. The Huntley Park District Athletic Administration will assist in mediating and resolving any conflicts which arise, if necessary.
- 7. Players, coaches, and spectators are subject to Huntley Park District Conduct Guidelines at all times. The Huntley Park District Athletic Administration shall have the right to suspend or remove individuals from the program as deemed necessary for failure to follow proper conduct guidelines.
- 8. Each family will be required to volunteer 2-4 hours of their time at the Huntley Hoop Fest, our annual tournament which will be held February 24th and 25th, 2018. Details on the available volunteer positions will be distributed to the teams as the tournament date draws closer.
