# Huntley Park District Adult Coed Volleyball League Rules

### Registration/Team Fees

Registration is done by team only. In order to reserve a spot in our league, a non-refundable \$100 deposit must be made approximately one (1) month prior to the start of the season.

Team Fees must be paid in-full ten (10) days prior to your first scheduled game. NO PAY-NO PLAY – Teams will not be allowed to play in any games until their league fees are paid in full.

### Roster & Player Eligibility

- Completed team rosters must be turned in to the scorekeeper prior to your first scheduled game of the season. Teams may include players on the roster with incomplete contact information or signatures, but no player may play in a game until they have completed and signed the roster. By signing the player roster, each player is agreeing to abide by all league rules and park district waivers and agreements.
- 2. Rosters should have a minimum of five (5) players and a maximum of twelve (12) players. The final day to add players in before your 3<sup>rd</sup> scheduled game. Once a player has participated in a game, they cannot play for any other team within the league for the remainder of the season.
- 3. To be eligible for the league, each player must meet the following criteria.
  - a. At least 18 years of age by the first scheduled league game.
  - b. Be on the team's official roster for which they are playing.
  - c. Must not be on more than one team's roster in the same league/level.

# The Game

#### All Rules will follow I.H.S.A. most current Rules except for the following league rules:

- 1. Forfeit time for the first game is five minutes after the scheduled starting time.
  - 2. Forfeit time for the match is ten minutes after the scheduled starting time.
  - 3. Coin flip determines which team which serve first in the first game of a match. Remaining games of a match start on the same court as the first game.
  - 4. Teams will be given two (2) thirty (30) second time-outs per team for each game.
  - 5. There is a sixty (60) minute time limit from the start of the match. When there are five minutes left in the match the referee will announce "NO TIME OUTS, 5 minutes left". If the first two games use the full hour, the third game winner will be the team that goes ahead by two points. Coin flip for serve with alternate serves.
  - 6. All three games are played, game is twenty-five (25) points (if ahead by two points) Max of twenty-nine (29) points. Rally scoring.
  - 7. When serving, the offense must alternate male and female and line-up as follows. Three (3) players in line in front of three (3) meter line, two (2) players in line back of three-(3) meter line.

Server (see rule #8)

- 8. The serve may be made anywhere on the serving line providing that the server is not in motion and is not screened by another offensive player.
- 9. A serve that touches the net and goes over is live and in play. A net serve may be attacked or blocked.
- 10. A non-net serve may not be attacked or blocked.
- 11. All players must be on the court until the ball leaves the servers hand.
- 12. A received serve may be set or bumped. If set, it may not be returned over the net. If bumped, it may be returned over the net.
- 13. Back row players cannot leave their feet beyond the three-(3) meter line.
- 14. If the ball hits the ceiling, curtain, fan or bleachers it is a dead ball.
- 15. If the ball touches the Net pole (if used) it is a dead ball.

# Players on the Court

- 1. Six (6) Players on the court three (3) male & three (3) Female. Teams may have a minimum of four (4) players to start a game (2 male & 2 Female).
- The number of males on the court may never exceed the number of females on the court. (Example: if 2 females and 3 males are in attendance that team must play 2 females and 2 males - if 3 females and 2 males are in attendance then all players may be on the court)
- 3. There is no limit on the number of female players on the court.
- 4. Player(s) arriving late may enter the game when ready. (Not in the serve position.)
- 5. Males and females on the offensive side of the court must be lined up on an alternative basis while the ball is being served. *If a team is playing with less than 6 players, the teams will be allowed to line up their players as they choose. When both teams are playing at full strength, teams must be lined up on an alternative basis.*
