REGISTRATION WAIVER & RELEASE

The Huntley Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Huntley Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for the below listed programs/activities must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Recreational activities are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Depending on the particular activity, participants must understand that certain risks, dangers and injuries due to inclement weather, slip and falls, poor skill level or conditioning, carelessness, horseplay, unsportsmanlike conduct, premises defects, inadequate or defective equipment, inadequate supervision, instruction or officiating, and all other circumstances inherent to indoor and outdoor recreational activities exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the (District/SRA) to guarantee absolute safety.

Due to the COVID-19 health and safety requirements, we will be implementing new rules and eligibility requirements for our day camps, which MAY include (but not limited to) requiring camp participants and staff to wear face coverings, to maintain 6 feet of social distance at all times possible, to follow basic instructions (in order to adhere to safety requirements), completing daily wellness screens, sitting in assigned seats for certain activities, and increased hand washing. **For customers who are requesting accommodation for a disability, please call our main office at (847) 669-3180 x. 1 and ask for the supervisor of the program you wish to enroll for at least two weeks prior to the activity begin date.**

We know these new changes can seem confusing or strange to children, and our staff are here to help them learn and be successful, including giving reminders and encouraging games and activities that will help the children to be successful. However, please understand that under our current circumstances, failure to comply with health and safety rules, whether intentional or not, may require removal from camp as outlined in our behavior management policy when it creates a direct threat to the safety of the patron, staff, or other campers in the program. Those situations will be evaluated on a case by case basis (and with input from the patron's family) and if the rules cannot be satisfied, participants may be removed from camp.

Please understand that we in no way are looking to create uncertainty or hardship to anyone. However, these requirements will be in line with current guidance from Illinois, the CDC, and other sources dedicated to securing the health and safety of the public, which is of paramount concern to the park district. Once the Phase 4 guidelines are released, this guidance may change, and this information will be updated as it is received. We appreciate your cooperation and working with your children to encourage these safety measures so that camp flows smoothly. **Thank you in advance for your cooperation!**
