CODE OF CONDUCT

The Huntley Park District insists that all participants comply with the following basic behavior code. All participants shall:

Program Rules:

- 1. Show respect to all participants, staff, and volunteers.
- 2. Participants should follow program rules and take direction from staff.
- 3. Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- 4. Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, or staff.
- 5. Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.
- 6. Not possess any weapons.

Discipline Procedures:

<u>First occurrence</u>: Verbal warning

<u>Second occurrence</u>: Time-out.

<u>Third occurrence</u>: Loss of Privilege. Conduct Report given. Parent/guardian notified. <u>Three Conduct Reports</u>: The Recreation Supervisor will contact a parent or guardian to request a meeting

(in person or over the phone as necessary) to discuss disciplinary problems and solutions.

NOTE Any violent, physical or threatening actions may receive an immediate conduct report and may result in a suspension from the program. The Park District reserves the right to suspend/dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers the safety of themselves or others, continues to violate program rules (intentionally or unintentionally) and/or if inappropriate behavior does not stop.
