POOL RULES

- Coolers are welcomed at Stingray Bay, however all coolers will be checked by Stingray Bay Staff for unapproved items such as alcohol or glass.
- Glass is not allowed in the facility. This includes baby food stored in glass containers.
- Controlled substances are not allowed in the facility. This includes alcohol and vaporizers. Smoking is permitted in designated smoking areas outside of Stingray Bay, and a stamp to re-enter the facility will be provided for individuals taking breaks to smoke.
- **Swim diapers or swim pants with elastic at the waist and thighs are required for children who are not potty-trained.** Reusable swim diapers are available for purchase at Stingray Bay or other retailers. Huggies swim diapers are not sufficient alone, but can be worn under a reusable swim diaper.
- **All food must be consumed in the grass or designated eating areas in accordance with the Illinois Department of Public Health.**
- Safety breaks will be announced at designated times. During safety breaks, only individuals 18 and older and infants who are unable to walk on their own.
- **All non-swimmers must remain within an arm's reach of an adult.**
- All lifejackets must be U.S. Coast Guard approved. All other personal flotation devices, including noodles, inner tubes, and unapproved lifejackets, are prohibited in the pool.
- Additional pool rules are posted at Stingray Bay.
